Biblical Examples of Prayers of Faith That Changed Lives. We Are in Bootcamp:

We're here to learn and grow in the understanding of the **power of a personal prayer of faith**. We want you to know that your faith can move mountains—just like these biblical examples—when approached with sincerity, humility, and trust.

Throughout scripture, we see how faith—expressed through sincere prayer—can bring about miracles, salvation, and divine intervention. James 5:15 states it is the prayer of faith that saves the sick. He further acknowledges it's the Lord who raises. Use these examples as you seek your perfect and powerful prayer of faith:

The Thief on the Cross (Luke 23:42-43)

In his final moments, the thief trusted Jesus and said, "Remember me when You come into Your kingdom."

This simple prayer of faith was enough to secure his salvation. Jesus responded with grace: "Today you will be with Me in paradise."

This is a perfect contrast—this man lived much of his life without prayer or faith, yet at his last moment, he declared a genuine prayer of faith, and Jesus responded.

- Mark 9:24 A father: Lord, I believe; help thou my unbelief.
- Matthew 8:5-13: The Centurion's faith amazed Jesus, and his servant was healed because of his confident belief.
- Mark 5:25-34: The woman with the issue of blood said, "If I only touch His clothes, I will be made well." Her persistent faith made her whole.
- Mark 10:46-52: The blind man's faith in Jesus healed him when he asked for sight.
- Luke 18:9-14: The tax collector's humble prayer of repentance was justified by God.
- Matthew 15:21-28: The woman's self-denigration, "The dogs eat the crumbs," led to her daughter's healing.
- Luke 18:1-8: The persistent widow's faith in prayer was rewarded with justice.

The Common Thread:

Each of these examples shows that **a sincere**, **personal prayer of faith**—no matter how small or last-minute—can activate God's power. The thief on the cross teaches us that **it's**

never too late to confess faith and believe. When you speak your honest prayer, trusting Jesus, He responds with grace and provision.
